(b) On Sunday 14th October we held our Annual Golf Tournament where we competed for The Colin Reid Memorial Trophy—The winner was Andy Mullen who was duly presented with his trophy by our branch Chairman Frank Murray. The tournament was held at The Dunfermline Golf Club and fortunately it remained dry.

(c) On Wednesday 17th October we had an “intermeeting pint” at the Guards Club in Edinburgh where we met up with Dougie Archibald.

(d) On 5th November some branch members , alongside members from the Lothian Branch of the PRA, attended the service at The Garden of Remembrance in Edinburgh.

(e) On Sunday 11th November four branch members attended the Remembrance Day Parade at “The Cenotaph” in London and a great time was had by all. It was very humbling and memorable.

Whilst we were there we were treated with the utmost of respect by numerous members of the public of all sects and creed.

It was good to catch up with our colleagues from south of the border.

We had a taxi driver who refused to take our fare, a train guard who gave us a complimentary upgrade to 1st Class, another railway official who made sure that we got on the train at the proper section in Carlisle, members of the public who made sure we got the proper restaurant to feed our faces in before departing for Scotland and last but not least a young Polish waitress who wished she was forty years older and Gordon fifty years younger.
